he popularity of our Camtwist skewers and seatpost binders on the NORBA circuit is due to much more than our incredibly low weight. Many racers including Rishi Grewall, Julianna Furtado, Darcey Dangremond-Wright, Cindy Devine and Greg Herbold have come to appreciate the way they work. Final tightening is accomplished with a twist of the lever, this motion locks the cam in an over center position that cannot be inadvertently opened. As Herbold puts it, "I feel secure in knowing that the levers cannot be accidentally flipped open when I'm hammering down the race course".

Wheel Skewers. The original way to "trim some fat." Solid and dependable. They're machined from 7075-T6 aluminum alloy and hand assembled to steel rods. (black, silver, blue and red). Save 3 oz. by switching from stock skewers. 104 grams per pair.

These are the original titanium rod skewers that are preferred by riders from 20 factory racing teams. They are the lightest wheel skewers in the world and are the easiest way to trim weight from a bike (no tools required). Replacing the stock seatpost binder and wheel skewers with *Ti-Stix* can save as much as 160 grams, that's over 51/2 ounces!

Ti-Stix are fabricated from 6AL-4V Titanium rod and hand assembled to 7075-T6 levers. Additional machining of the levers reduces weight even further. Annodized in seven colors, (black, silver, blue, red, gold, cammo green and Team Issue 3D Violet). Only 83 grams per pair!




